The lectures are recorded and posted on YouTube.

In the above syllabus, each week of the semester other than the last one has, among its assigned homework, three homework problem numbers marked by asterisks. These are the problems that have to be turned in for credit. On every Wednesday, starting June 23rd, by the end of the day, you will be required to post on Carmen your solutions of the three asterisk-marked problems assigned in the preceding week (M-W-F).

Each of the three problems will be graded with a maximum of ten points. Partial credit will be given wherever appropriate, and errors marked in red.

The three exams (two midterms and the final) will be given, respectively, on Friday, June 25th; Friday, July 16th; and Friday, July 30th, as indicated in the syllabus. They will all have a take-home format: in the morning of the day of the exam, it will become available on Carmen and you will have time till the end of the day to complete the exam and post it on Carmen. You can use your notes, but everyone should work individually.

Both midterms consist of four problems, worth 25 points each, and the final has six problems, totalling 200 points.

There will be no lectures, and no office hours, on July 5th and on the exam days (June 25th, July 16th, July 30th).
