**CALCULATORS:** Calculators **ARE** permitted during quizzes, midterm exams and the final exam, except those calculators that have symbolic algebra or calculus capabilities. In particular, the following calculators and their upgrades, are **NOT** permitted: TI-89, TI-92, TI Voyage 200, HP-48, HP-49, Casio FX2.0, and Casio CFX 9970G. It is also not permitted to use higher memory functions on a calculator, e.g., to store and read formulae. This will be considered (the electronic equivalent of) using notes during exams, which is prohibited and hence academic misconduct. Furthermore, PDAs, cell phones, pagers or any other electronic communication devices as well as all laptops **must be turned off** during all quizzes and exams. Violations of this policy will be referred to the Committee on Academic Misconduct. You are allowed to use basic arithmetic and graphing functions on a calculator that is not excluded above.

**RECITATION:** You will meet with your recitation instructor on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Your performance in recitation will count for 20% your grade and will consist of collected homework and in-class quizzes:

- **HOMEWORK:** Your homework assignments will be listed on the course homepage. These assignments will be updated throughout the quarter so make sure that you check them regularly. You are expected to complete each assignment and turn in the indicated problems by the due date listed on the calendar. In total, the homework will count for 10% of your grade. Homework that is turned in one day late will be downgraded by 50% of the total available points. **Homework will not be accepted more than one day, NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- **QUIZZES:** There will a total of seven quizzes given by your recitation teacher during the quarter. You will be allowed to drop your lowest quiz score. In total, the homework will count for 10% of your grade. There will be **NO** makeup for a missed quiz.

- **MIDTERMS:** There will be two 48 minute midterm exams given during the quarter. They will be given on a lecture day at the usual time and place. The midterm exams will each count for 20% of your grade.
